REPORT BACK OF LAST EVENT.

The chairman again pointed out at the drivers briefing that safety and respect for fellow competitors was paramount. After two start attempts the race sequence and start was well maintained and a special thanks to all.

It was again pointed out that incident reports MUST be lodged with the COC in the correct time frame applicable.

The members were again reminded of their conduct after and during race events in the clubhouse as some issues were again noted.

Gate attendance was made mention of as 3360 spectators attended and 1700 were paying public with the balance being members and race complementary.

FEEDBACK FROM SPORTSCOM/MANCOM.

Ian confirmed that under trays/nappies will be compulsory as instructed by Sportcom and the WPMC from the September race meeting. This applies to all categories. If the above is not in place the competitor concerned will be liable for the consequences in the event of an oil spill on their vehicles. - 2) Proposed was that the pre-race paddock be used for qualifying to assemble cars in their class. This was investigated. To keep the classes and competitors evenly matched as a safety and traffic concern. It seemed to work well and to continue.
- 3) There is no weaving allowed in qualifying at all. This must be implemented.
- 4) Next race event – 05 September.
- 5) Scrutineers are doing their best and do not need competitors to go off on a tangent, if you have issues speak to Ley or myself and we will address with them to sort out any issues which may arise. We must all be respectful of each other's and comply. Of concern was the Spigot ring issue arising again against some competitors.
- 6) We need to respect each other, families and friends and unite as a section for success in the tough times ahead. Stand united and we will stay on top.
- 7) Year-end social annual prize giving set at 28 November, tickets at R150 per head.

Rules meeting:

3 rules proposals were discussed and voted on by the adjudicator being Clint Rennard, all votes were tallied as explained as per rule specified in rule 28

The only rule change will be as highlighted and to be entered into the rules :

Any driver that records a lap time faster than a 1 minute 21.00 will be immediately black flagged and will not be allowed to complete race/heat. He/she will be disqualified from the results and be precluded from further participation on the day, and will also be precluded from competing in Clubmans for the next three (3) race meetings.

If competitor returns after 3 race day/meeting ban and at any time records a lap time quicker than a 1 minute 21.00, irrespective of what vehicle he/she races, he/she will be immediately black flagged and will not be allowed to complete race/heat. He/she will be disqualified from the results and be precluded from further participation on the day, and will also be precluded from competing in Clubmans for the next six (6) race meetings.

If competitor returns after 6 race day/meeting ban and at any time records a lap time quicker than a 1 minute 21.00, irrespective of what vehicle he/she races, he/she will be immediately black flagged and will not be allowed to complete race/heat. He/she will be disqualified from the results and be precluded from further participation on the day, and will also be precluded from competing in Clubmans for the next twelve (12) race meetings.

If competitor returns after 12 race day/meeting ban and at any time records a lap time quicker than a 1 minute 21.00, irrespective of what vehicle he/she races, he/she will be immediately black flagged and will not be allowed to complete race/heat. He/she will be disqualified from the results and be precluded from further participation on the day, and will also be precluded from competing in Clubmans indefinitely.

The results were tallied up and 22 members were eligible to vote, 35 in attendance. The results were accepted and submitted accordingly.

No further points were made and rules meeting closed.
