More attention needs to be given to build safety and seat safety on race cars..

No-one formed up on Grid on the outside extremities of the track for 2nd heat...

After incident with Gavin there were several people who were publicly commenting on Gavin...follow process with protests and incident reports and don't air dirty laundry where spectators can hear. This does not benefit Clubmans or WPMC

Competitors were again reminded to inform Clint if you are not competing in the following heat.

Competitors were reminded to enter the track at a safe angle and point and not at 90%.

Starts were discussed in detail. Competitors **MUST** get the starts correct. Pole sitter must back up from turn 3. Whom ever does not abide, starts from pit lane. Competitors who do not maintain the required distance or weave excessively will be made to start the next race from pit lane.

Pace Car was discussed- limit of 100km / hour. Race will be aborted if pace not correct, will have to come around for another start
